CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE

The European Union Directive 2002/95/EC Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) legislation restricts the use of certain substances in electrical and electronic equipment. This directive applies to all electrical or electronic products and their components placed on the market after July 1, 2006. The substances include Lead (Pb), Mercury (Hg), Cadmium (Cd), Hexavalent Chromium (CR⁺⁶), Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB), and Polybrominated diphenyls (PBDE).

Nor-Cote International, Inc. does not intentionally add or utilize any of the above mentioned heavy metals or brominated flame-retardants in the manufacturing of our products. However, naturally occurring residuals not exceeding the proposed maximum concentration levels of the RoHS Directive may be found in raw materials used in our products or from the manufacturing processes of our suppliers.

To the best of our knowledge and intent, all Nor-Cote products are believed to be in compliance with the RoHS Directive. It is Nor-Cote's policy to comply with all current and future foreseeable standards.
